Acute Sinusitis



Acute bacterial sinusitis is an infection of the sinus cavities. Excessive mucus, bacterial growth, plus inflammation all contribute to sinusitis. It usually begins with a cold, an allergy attack, or an irritation by environmental pollutants. When you have a cold or allergy attack, your sinuses become inflamed and are unable to drain excess mucus. This can cause infection, intense discomfort and may lead to more serious complication (Sinusitis) if left untreated.

Chronic Sinusitis

Sinus infections that occur frequently or last longer than eight weeks are common indications of chronic sinusitis. Symptoms may be less severe than those of acute sinusitis. However, untreated chronic sinusitis can cause damage to the sinuses, which may require surgery.



Sinus Surgery

When sinusitis is left untreated, severe damage can be caused to the sinuses and surrounding tissues. Usually Sinus Surgery is performed to relieve nasal blockage, promote proper drainage and aid in the removal of inflamed tissue in the nasal cavities and sinuses.

After surgery there is less tissue in the sinuses which can make it difficult for systemic (oral) medications to reach the affected area. Sinus Dynamics™ offers topical treatments which deliver medications directly into the nasal and sinus regions.

Aerosolized Therapy

Aerosolized therapy allows the user to deliver antibiotic, antifungal and anti-inflammatory medications directly into the affected areas within the sinuses.

Medicated Irrigation Therapy

Nasal Irrigation is often recommended as a daily routine to help cleanse the nasal passages of excess mucus and allergens and can be used with physician prescribed solutions.

- The ActiveSinus™ brand includes a preservative free natural sea salt mixture.
- Its custom molded irrigator does not include an inner tube eliminating the risk of trapped bacteria.



Atomized Therapy

Atomized therapy uses positive pressure to propel solutions deep within the nasal passages and sinus cavities.

- The NasaTouch™ Portable Powered Atomizer device has the ability to atomize 2 mL of solution in only 30 seconds
- The NasaTouch™ device can be used with physician prescribed solutions to be administered directly into the nasal passages and sinus cavities.
